

## Designated Guest Policy

A **Designated Guest** is an individual invited by an unmarried member (“Sponsoring Member”) to participate in a Club activity for which a guest fee is normally charged and for which there is a limitation on the number of visits, but both are waived (except as otherwise provided below) when all of the following conditions are met:

- a. The Sponsoring Member must be unmarried, and the proposed Designated Guest must be unmarried.
- b. The Sponsoring Member must complete the *Designated Guest Application* (“Application”) and deliver it to the General Manager for approval.
- c. The Sponsoring Member must verify that the relationship with the proposed Designated Guest is of a committed relationship rather than strictly platonic, or business or family (whether by blood or marriage) relationship.
- d. The Designated Guest must be accompanied by the Sponsoring Member at all times while on the Club’s property. Sponsoring Members are responsible for their guests while on property and must ensure the Designated Guest knows and adheres to the appropriate Club’s Rules and Regulations (“Rules”). In completing and signing the *Application*, the Sponsoring Member agrees to be financially responsible for all charges to the Sponsoring Member’s account relating to the Designated Guest.
- e. All privileges (except for number of visit limitations and fees as described below) of the Designated Guest and rules and limitations applicable to the Designated Guest shall be the same as a Guest as stated in the Club Bylaws and Rules.
- f. Guest number of visit limitations (**with the exception of golf visits**) will be waived for the Designated Guest upon the Club’s approval of the Application. The Designated Guest shall have the same golf number of visit limitations as a Social Member as stated in the Club Bylaws and Rules.
- g. Guest fees (**with the exception of golf guest fees**) will be waived for the Designated Guest upon the Club’s approval of the Application and receipt by the Club of the Sponsoring Member Affidavit and Designated Guest Agreement.
- h. The Designated Guest shall pay the same golf fees and be restricted to the same golf Restricted Play Periods as Immediate Family as stated in the Club Bylaws and Rules. The Designated Guest is not eligible to be a Guest for golfing purposes with any member of the Club other than the Sponsoring Member.
- i. The guest fees and number of visit limitations are **not** waived for the children, step-children or dependents of the Designated Guest or any other family relations of the Designated Guest.
- j. A Sponsoring Member may only designate and have one individual as Designated Guest in a 12-month period.
- k. The Designated Guest will retain the privileges stated within this Designated Guest Policy until such designation is revoked by the Sponsoring Member or the Board. Either the Sponsoring Member or the Board may revoke the Designated Guest’s designation and privileges without prior notice or cause.
